COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAM

>>> LEARNING ON WHEELS

Our “Learning on Wheels” community outreach program is supporting three partner NGOs and community schools. They are Ashraya Centre for Learning, Grace Foundation Charitable Trust and Christ Jubilee Memorial Study Centre. The program focuses on providing special education support, pre-vocational training, digital literacy and spoken English classes for students with special needs as well as children from weaker economic section of the community. Our dedicated trainers engage with these individuals twice in a week, using interactive activities and enjoyable games to foster their learning in essential areas as well as building communication and social skills. The ultimate goal of this community outreach initiative is to extend assistance to over 119 children with special needs in our community, ensuring they receive the necessary support and opportunities to thrive and succeed.

>>> SARATHY INCLUSIVE EDUCATION PROJECT

A total of 22 teachers attended this session actively and they are going to implement these methods with more than 800 children who are studying govt. schools.

Akshadhaa Foundation Conducted a Physiotherapy Camp at Grace Foundation, Kamalahalli from 10:00 am - 1:00 pm. This camp proved to be of significant benefit to more than 45 individuals, including children, family caregivers and teachers of the NGO. The camp focused on providing home program, effective physiotherapy techniques to work with children afflicted with conditions such as Cerebral Palsy, Intellectual Disability, and Multiple Disabilities.
